Exhibitors will be sent an Entry Pass to the Show on return of this Entry Form. Sticks must be in place by 10.45am. Judging will commence at 11am prompt. Presentations will be made at 4.30pm. Sticks can be collected after the presentation.

COMPETITION RULES

SUNDAY 31st July 2022

1. Entry is free, open to all comers, but limited to THREE STICKS PER CLASS
2. Entry form must be returned by **Saturday 16th JULY 2022**
3. Sticks entered, must be the work of the competitors
4. **No** sticks to be entered bearing competitors name or brand on any part of the stick
5. Walking sticks in classes 3, 4, & 19 must be 40 inch or under in length, while market sticks in classes 5, 6, & 18 **must** be over 40 inch
6. A stick with any kind of decoration can only be entered in Classes 11, 12 & 15
7. Novice classes confined to persons who have not competed in any stick making competition before 1st January 2019
8. The stewards will have authority to decide in which class any stick should be entered
9. All entries **MUST** be in place by 10.45am
10. Judging will commence at 11am prompt
11. The judge decision is final
12. Prizes will be presented at 4.30pm
13. No stick to be removed before 4.30pm
14. Stewarding of sticks will be undertaken, but the organisers cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage
