EQUINE INFLUENZA

Horses must have been vaccinated to comply with the requirements of the primary course (1st vaccination and then 2nd vaccination between 21 – 92 days later), followed by the first booster (150 – 215 days) and all subsequent boosters. Horses may compete having received the primary course and prior to the first booster but not within 7 days of receiving a vaccine dose.

Horses must have been vaccinated within 12 months before the show but not less than 7 days of arriving at the show.

LOCAL BRED HORSES & PONIES – CLASS WITHIN A CLASS

IN EVERY CLASS EXHIBITORS WITH A GOWER BRED HORSE OR PONY WILL RECEIVE A QUALIFYING CARD FOR THE BEST IN SHOW GOWER BRED CLASS. THIS CLASS IS OPEN TO ANY HORSE OR PONY BRED ON THE GOWER PENINSULA. PLEASE STATE BREEDER OR STUD ON ENTRY.

NO PRIZE MONEY WILL BE AWARDED AND NO ADDITIONAL ENTRY FEES HOWEVER, EXHIBITORS MUST PAY TO ENTER THE MAIN CLASS.

FOALS

In-foal mares that have already had vaccinations of primary Equine Influenza course should be vaccinated 4-6 weeks before the foal is due to be born.

Foals should be vaccinated for Equine Influenza at 6 months to commence their primary course.

We urge all owners to adhere to strict biosecurity protocols at all times.

Vaccinations are subject to local risk assessments by the attending veterinarians.

PLEASE NOTE THAT NEITHER VACCINATION CERTIFICATES NOR PASSPORTS SHOULD BE SENT TO THE SHOW OFFICE PRIOR TO THE EVENT. HOWEVER, RANDOM CHECKS MAY BE CARRIED OUT ON THE SHOWGROUND DURING THE SHOW

All horse passports should be available for inspection, if required. **ENTRIES** - Due to time constraints entries for all classes may be limited, so please ensure your entry is in early to avoid disappointment. **FARRIER** - Mr Richard Francis will be in attendance at the show. **MOBILE PHONES** - Mobiles are not permitted within judging rings. **DRESS CODE** - Grooms/Attendants appearing with animals in the judging rings must be in proper dress code with appropriate headwear. **SHOWING ORDER** - The Showing timetable may be altered at the Secretaries/Chief Steward's discretion and the times are only a GUIDELINE. There will be a 10 min call before your section is called for judging. No classes can be held over for ANY competitor and if changing the running order causes clashing of classes the show cannot be held liable. Competitors are advised when entering to consider the timetable. No horse/pony can enter the ring when judging has commenced.

SECTION A - WELSH MOUNTAIN PONIES NOT EXCEEDING 12.0 HH (121.9CMS)

Class

- 1 **Mare or Gelding**, four years old and over.
- 2 **Colt or Filly foal**
- 3 **Yearling Filly or Gelding**
- 4 **Two year old Colt, Filly or Gelding**
- 5 **Three year old Colt, Filly or Gelding**

CHAMPIONSHIP: Open to 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 1 - 6.

THE FARAAM CHALLENGE CUP to the Champion of this section.

SECTION B - WELSH PONIES NOT EXCEEDING 13.2HH (137.2CMS)

Classes may be combined if insufficient entries

CHAMPIONSHIP: Open to 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 19 - 24

The PENMYNYDD PERPETUAL CHALLENGE CUP to the Champion of this section.

OVERALL WELSH IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP: OPEN TO CHAMPION AND RESERVE FROM SECTIONS A, B, C & D. The CEULAN STARLET SHIELD to overall Welsh Champion

LOCAL SECTION & MISCELLANEOUS

- 25 **Best Pony Club/Riding Club pony or horse** - open to any pony or horse of any size to be ridden by a rider of suitable age and capability. Required to jump a small rustic style jump. Class will be split age/height if sufficient entries.
- 26 **Best Local Pony** - open to Mares and Geldings 4 years old and over, not exceeding 14.2hh (148cms) most suitable for and to be ridden by a child not having attained their 17th Birthday on 1st January in the current year. Class will be split age of rider/height if sufficient entries.
- 27 **Best local Horse or pony** - open to Mares and Geldings 4 years old and over, to be ridden by an adult 18 years & above.
For Classes 26 & 27 Competitors must reside within the boundary of City and County of Swansea.

- 28 **Child Handler**- 8 years and under / 9 – 12 years / 13 years and over (2 older sections may be combined if insufficient entries)

- 29 **RIDERS 16 YEARS OF AGE AND UNDER** - ROSETTES TO ALL COMPETITORS ALONG WITH PRIZES FOR EACH ENTRY FORWARD FOR JUDGING

CHILDREN'S RIDING PONIES

- 30 **LEADING REIN PONY** - open to Mares and Geldings 4 years old and over, not exceeding 12hh (122cms) most suitable for and to be ridden by a child not having attained his or her 8th birthday 1st January in the current year. Snaffle bridles only.

THE PRIORSWOOD TROPHY AND ROSETTE

Presented by Mr & Mrs Tardioli will be awarded to the best exhibit in class 30

- 31 **FIRST RIDDEN PONY** - open to Mares and Geldings 4 years old and over, not exceeding 12hh (122cms) most suitable for and to be ridden by a child not having attained his or her 10th birthday on 1st January in the current year. Snaffle bridles only.

THE JOHN TAYLOR PERPETUAL MEMORIAL TROPHY will be awarded to the best exhibit in class 31

- 32 **MIXED HEIGHT SHOW PONY OR SHOW HUNTER PONY** - open to mares and geldings 4 years old and over. Show ponies not exceeding 14.2hh (148cms) most suitable for and to be ridden by a child not having attained their 17th birthday on 1st January in the current year. Show hunter ponies not exceeding 15hh (153cms) most suitable for and to be ridden by a child not having attained their 20th birthday on 1st January in the current year. Snaffle bridles are acceptable.

THE BLUE PETER CUP - Presented in memory of Mrs D Thomas will be awarded to the winner of class 32.

- 33 **CHILDRENS RIDING PONY CHAMPIONSHIP** - Open to 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 30 - 32

Notes to Leading Rein Competitors:

In Leading Rein classes, the rein **MUST** go directly from the bit to the rider's hand, with no extra aid or attachment to, or on the saddle. The reins must be a normal length and not knotted or stitched together at a shorter length.

In Leading Rein classes, handles on the saddles are permitted but reins **MUST NOT** be attached to the saddle or to the handle.

- 39 **Best Racehorse to Riding Horse** - Horses 15hh and over, 4 yrs old and over, rider to be 16 year and over. Horses must compete under original name registered at Weatherbys. Class will be judged in a Riding Class format and must be plaited.
- 40 **Riding Cob** - (Lightweight or Heavyweight, Maxi) Mare or Gelding, 4 years & over exceeding 14.2hh (148cms) to be ridden by a lady or gentleman. THE BLACKHILLS TROPHY will be awarded to the Winner of this class.

CHAMPIONSHIP: Open to 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 37 - 40.

THE FOXWELL CHALLENGE CUP: Will be awarded to the Champion.
