COMPETITION RULES

SUNDAY 3rd August 2025

- 1. Entry is free, open to all comers, but limited to THREE STICKS PER CLASS
- 2. Entry form must be returned by **Saturday 19th July 2025**
- 3. Sticks entered, must be the work of the competitors
- No sticks to be entered bearing competitors name or brand on any part of the stick
- 5. Walking sticks in classes 3, 4,17 & 18 must be 40 inch or under in length, while market sticks in classes 5, 6, 17 & 18 must be over 40 inch
- 6. A stick with any kind of decoration can only be entered in Classes 11, 12, 17 & 18
- Novice classes confined to persons who have not competed in any stick making competition before 1st January 2023
- The stewards will have authority to decide in which class any stick should be entered
- 9. All entries **MUST** be in place by 10.45am
- 10. Judging will commence at 11am prompt
- 11. The judge decision is final
- 12. Prizes will be presented at 4.30pm
- 13. No stick to be removed before 5pm
- 14. Stewarding of sticks will be undertaken, but the organisers cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage

Vehicle parking

The Society has a responsibility to maintain the Park's high standard. Therefore, exhibitors bringing their entries on Saturday and early Sunday morning may have to park their vehicles a little further from the marquee. There will be help available from volunteers for multiple entries.

THIRD PARTY LIABILITY

The Society, its Officers or Servants, shall not be responsible to any person whatsoever while on the Society's premises or while entering or leaving same, for any damage or loss however caused, to the property of any such person or for any injury fatal or otherwise to any such person.

The Society, its Officers or Servants shall not be responsible for any accident, damage or loss, however caused, that may occur to any exhibitor or his servant, or to any animal, article or property, brought into the Showground, or while entering or leaving or being carried into or out of the said Showground. Each exhibitor shall be solely responsible for any loss, injury or damage that may be done to or occasioned by, or arising from any animal, article or property exhibited or brought on to the Showground by him, and he shall indemnify and hold harmless the Society from and against all actions, suits, expenses and claims on account of or in respect of any such damage or injury which may be caused or occasioned.
